Criteria were recommended; the Executive Committee revised the criteria. The observer position was advertised in <i>The Messenger</i> . No applications were received.
NBI 25-3	ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR DISTRICTS	ADOPTED	FINANCE COMMITTEE	3/7/26	<p>During the 2025-2026 fiscal year, funding was provided for all districts at a rate of one-fourth of dues paid (increasing from \$6.50 to \$12 per member out of the \$48 annual dues paid by each member). Allocations for communications and district flat grants were folded into the formula. The resulting budget was implemented with a deficit of \$18,650. The districts realized the following allocation changes compared to the previous (2024-2025) fiscal year:</p> <p>Hawai'i: +13.0% \$1,248 Kaua'i: -32.2% (\$2,148.50) Maui: +1.4% \$113 O'ahu: +47% \$16,266</p> <p>The allocations to community clubs was held to \$4/member, and accounted for an additional \$2,376 for Hawaii and Maui districts.</p>
